Duties and responsibilities

Qualifications

- Minimum one year experience driving a commercial vehicle.
- Construction site driving is experience preferred
- Valid CDL Class B or Higher REQUIRED with a clean record
- Must have valid Medical Certification Card
- Must be 18 years old or older
- Must have high degree of attention and considerable dexterity in the control of the vehicle to ensure proper safe delivery.
- Must be able to lift up to 100 lbs of equipment at any given time.
- Understanding of code and compliance
- Perform daily inspections of company vehicle and report any and all defects immediately
- Must be able to bend, squat, lift, climb and carry heavy equipment in a safe manner

Working conditions

- May be expected to travel out of town to work on projects.

- Work in most weather conditions and in conditions that may be noisy, wet, cold, dirty and dusty.

Physical requirements

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- The employee may at times lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
