Job title	Crane Truck Operator
Reports to	Residential – Foundation Operations Superintendent

Job purpose

The Boom Crane Truck Operator must always maintain a valid CDL. The Boom Crane Operator is responsible for driving and operating a boom crane safely, in addition to being responsible for the daily maintenance of the crane truck. The operator coordinates the placement of his truck and the movement of material to and from the job site, per the layout as it relates to the structural foundation. Further, this position supports the crews in making the process easy for them. Requires a minimum of boom crane truck certification or training performed internally by lead crane truck operator.

Duties and responsibilities

- Drive safely to job sites.
- Operate boom crane in a safe manner.
- Be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness and operations of the boom crane. Inspect and maintain equipment every day to ensure safety and prevent damage to equipment and surrounding structures.
- Responsible for managing forms in the Rusin's inventory system and communicating with superintendents and foreman for delivery.
- Support the crews in ensuring the panel placement for the unloading and loading process is easy for them.
- Meet daily production goals working closely with Project Coordinator, job site foreman and/or superintendent.
- Submits DVIR's daily for crane truck.
- Follow all safety rules and regulations as required, including wearing all PPE.
- Always maintain CDL requirements and attends required certification training as deemed necessary by Supervisor.
- Assist in the training of new drivers as needed, assess when training is complete and when more training is needed.
- From time to time and as needed, may be assigned to working with others on wall/strip crew and mechanic.

Competencies

- Knowledge of and attention to safety procedures while performing driving and materials handling tasks.
- Good verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to read and understand maps, routes, road signs.
- Excellent customer service skills.

- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out route assignment.
- Ability to read and understand machine and equipment diagrams and system schematics.
- Mechanical aptitude and strong problem-solving skills
- Knowledge of basic math and measurements skills.
- Must have a CDL license and comply with all state and federal regulations.
- Must have a boom crane certification or finish Rusin's training course.
- Must possess the ability to learn and grow with the company.
- Neat and clean dress is a must.
- High school diploma or General Education Degree (GED), two (2) years driving experience and a minimum of a two weeks, hands on training conducted by Rusin Concrete.

Working conditions/Physical activity

The work environment and physical activity described are representative of those that must be met by and employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Work is performed within a production environment, subject to temperature variations, hazardous chemicals, mechanical parts, increased noise levels and dust.
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 25 pounds frequently and occasion up to 100 pounds.
- Must be able to physically operate crane equipment (climb up and down into cab, twist torso for 360-degree visibility, use arms to operate controls, etc.)

Physical requirements

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand; talk or hear; walk; and use hands to finger, handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
