Job Title	Pump Truck Operator
Reports To	Pump Operator Supervisor

Job purpose

The Pump Operator must always maintain a valid CDL. The Pump Operator is responsible for driving and operating a pump safely, in addition to being responsible for the daily maintenance of the pump truck. The operator coordinates the placement of ready-mix concrete through a pump at job sites, sets up concrete delivery systems, monitors the movement of concrete to locations where it is poured, and resolves issues related to the pouring of the pump-able concrete. Further, this position supports the crews in making the process easy for them. Requires a minimum of pump operator certification or training performed internally by Pump Operator Supervisor.

Duties and responsibilities

- Drive safely to job sites.
- Operate pump in a safe manner.
- Be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness and operations of the pump. Inspect and maintain pump/boom equipment every day in order to ensure safety and prevent damage to equipment and surrounding structures.
- Support the crews in ensuring the pour process is easy for them.
- Meet daily production goals working closely with Project Coordinator, job site foreman and superintendent.
- Submits DVIR's daily for pump truck.
- Wear PPE daily.
- Always maintain CDL requirements and attends required certification training as deemed necessary by Supervisor.
- From time to time and as needed, may be assigned to working with others on wall/strip crew and mechanic.
- Please note this job description is not designed to cover or contain a comprehensive listing of activities, duties or responsibilities that are required of the employee for this job. Duties, responsibilities, and activities may change at any time with or without notice.

Competencies

- Knowledge of and attention to safety procedures while performing driving and materials handling tasks.
- Good verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to read and understand maps, routes, road signs.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out route assignment.
- Ability to read and understand machine and equipment diagrams and system schematics.
- Mechanical aptitude and strong problem-solving skills
- Knowledge of basic math and measurements skills.
- Must have a CDL license and comply with all state and federal regulations.
- Must fully comply with ACPA rules and regulations.
- Must maintain a pump certification following required 12 months of experience and finish Rusin's training course.

- Must possess the ability to learn and grow with the company.
- Neat and clean dress is a must.
- High school diploma or General Education Degree (GED), two (2) years driving experience and a minimum of a two weeks, hands on training conducted by Rusin Concrete.

Working conditions/Physical activity

The work environment and physical activity described are representative of those that must be met by and employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Work is performed within a production environment, subject to temperature variations, hazardous chemicals, mechanical parts, increased noise levels and dust.
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 25 pounds frequently and occasion up to 100 pounds.
- Must be able to physically operate crane equipment (climb up and down into cab, twist torso for 360-degree visibility, use arms to operate controls, etc.)

Physical requirements

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand; talk or hear; walk; and use hands to finger, handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
